<b>Big6 #1: Task Definition</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Does the information in your final product meet (or exceed) the requirements of the assignment?</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Does your final product meet your teacher's expectations?</li></ul>
<b>Big6 #2: Information Seeking Strategies</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Did the books, web sites, and other resources you used meet the needs of the assignment?</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Did you select the best sources available to you? How do you know?</li></ul>
<b>Big6 #3: Location &amp; Access</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Did you locate the sources you needed?</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Did you find the information you needed in each source?</li></ul>
<b>Big6 #4: Use of Information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Were you able to effectively identify the information you needed?</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Were you able to effectively take notes or gather information?</li></ul>
<b>Big6 #5: Synthesis</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Did you effectively organize information?</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Does your product present the information clearly?</li></ul>
